Preparation work

1. Download the Part 1 Transition pack also watch the video explaining the pack.
 - 'SUBJECTS' > 'SCIENCE' > 'KS5 BIOLOGY'
 - 'COURSE INFORMATION' on the page
 - Folder marked, '*Year 11 into 12 summer study tasks 2020*'
 - **Folder 'PART 1'**
2. I will send out a link for you to join my Microsoft TEAMS classroom via FROG when I know who you are. Check your emails. If you cannot join the group do not worry, I will be setting the work via FROG just not videos and live lessons.

Tasks

The aim of these tasks is to reinforce and retain knowledge from GCSE to also bridge the GAP between GCSE and A-level. These tasks will also give you skills needed for the A-level course.

All work set must be kept organised for handing in, to be checked the first week of A-level biology.

1. **Read to page 5.** These are some thought provoking books, long and short films. If you have time, please read and watch. There will be a reading task in transition PACK 2 so you could wait until then.
2. **Page 6 shows you the Cornell note taking technique.** This is a technique which will make your life much easier during your A-levels. You are to use the Cornell technique for each of the 5 research activities on page 7+8.
3. **Page 9-13 has research tasks.** You will carry out each of these tasks. These tasks improve your understanding of the basic concepts in biology and prep you for the investigative skills you will need for the course. These will be set over a 3-week period. Work will be submitted VIA FROG.
4. **Next few pages are not possible during LOCKDOWN.** If it is lifted these are optional.
5. **Page 19—24 exam questions at the end.** Try them in test conditions (40min) and self-mark. **How did you find them?** I will hope for you to get over 60%. If not, can you show me reflection work using the Cornell technique.
