A-Level Geography

Here is a summary of the work that all prospective A-Level Geography students should carry out before starting the course in September.

This has been designed to prepare you for some of the new content that you will be learning in year 12 and also develop some of the skills you will need, such as fieldwork skills.

You will be provided with

- The A-Level Geography handbook, which contains everything you need to know for the A-Level Geography course. (PLCs, reading list, keywords etc)
- The Covid-19 fieldwork project booklet

Activities

1. Complete the Covid-19 fieldwork project, using the booklet. (Time- 5-6 hours)
2. Use your revision guide (pages 81-91) to make detailed notes on the GCSE topic 'Ice on the Land'. Complete the revision questions on page 91. (Time 5-6 hours). You will be studying a Glaciation topic in year 12, for which this is essential preparation.
3. Use the reading list in the A-Level Geography handbook to spend time reading about parts of the course that you find especially interesting or new.

The deadline for these activities is your first lesson in September.
