

FROME COLLEGE - SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

Although there is no uniform requirement for Sixth Form students and you may wear clothes of your own choosing, it is crucial that students understand that clothing should be suitable for the **working environment** and must not interfere with your core aim of learning and achieving.

It is our expectation that all Sixth Form students will act as role models to our younger students, as ambassadors to the community, locally and nationally and to dress accordingly. To this end, clothing which could cause offence to others (by wording, imagery, being too revealing etc) or otherwise 'not appropriate' for school is **not permitted**.

ALL Sixth Form students must adhere to the following :

- Hats, caps and hoods are not to be worn indoors.
- Miniskirts, short shorts (no more than 6" from the bottom of the knee) are not acceptable.
- Cropped or strappy tops are not to be worn.
- Tops which expose the abdomen, midriff or excessive cleavage are not acceptable.
- T-shirts or other tops with offensive or inflammatory wording/imagery are not permitted.
- All 'Beachwear' items, including crop-tops, bikini tops, swimming shorts and flip flops/bare feet, are not permitted
- Excessive facial piercings are not permitted.

Coats and outdoor wear should be removed promptly at the start of lessons and when in Frome Futures.

In certain circumstances, there may be additional clothing guidelines for health and safety reasons (such as face-masks) and students **MUST** follow these directives. They must also adhere to the expectations of any subject/department e.g. science: any footwear that does not cover the whole foot, no shorts, hair tied-back etc.

Any persistent breach of the Dress Code will result in disciplinary action.***
